Influenced by funk pioneers The Meters and James Brown's The JB's, leading London jazz funk band Groove Digger's smoldering sound is laced with heat of the moment improvisation, whipped into biting street-style grooves. With a mission to blend top notch jazz musicians with slamming funk, ska, reggae and Afro grooves, Groove Digger Collective live up to their name, delving deep into driving beats and bass lines, frenetic percussion hooked to an exciting horn section and funky guitar.

Combining all this on a set of smoldering jazz funk classics from the JB's, The Meters, Aaron Neville and Eddie Harris alongside their own dynamic originals Groove Digger are that rare thing – a jazz band that knows how to lay down the funk – and a funk band that knows how to stretch and burn on solos. From cool school grooves to hard-hitting funk Groove Digger Collective get the dance floor rocking and the sound system shaking.

He has encountered many different musicians along the way and is pleased to have played with (amongst others) : Pee Wee Ellis, Alex Garnett, Matt Wates, Bobby Wellins, Alec Dankworth, Alan Barnes, Martin Drew, Ben Clatworthy, Dave O'Higgins, Mark Ramsden, Julian Siegel, Mike Gorman, Mike Outram, Pete Long, Frank Griffith, Dave Cliff, Steve Waterman and Laurence Cottle. Nigel performed with the legendary David Axelrod at the Royal Festival Hall in 2004 and also spent more than two years as the regular guitarist with the Sheena Davis group.

Liane is one of the leading lights on the UK and world jazz scene. Her talents as a singer, composer and piano player are matched equally by her wonderful warm and down to earth personality. A truly natural talent.

REUBAN RICHARDS & THE SOUL TRAIN 03 NOV



Reuben Richards is a versatile soul/blues R&B lover's rock vocalist. He is a dead ringer for Otis Redding and performs accordingly in this seven piece band, with a style highly reminiscent of the golden age of soul – the Classic Stax Atlantic Sounds.

JEREMY SASSOON 08 NOV



Already one of the most in-demand jazz pianists and bandleaders, Jeremy Sassoon launches his solo career in 2011 as a vocal artist; his distinctive and evocative style encompassing genres of Jazz, Blues and Soul.

As a keyboard player/MD, he has already appeared at the North Sea Jazz Festival (The Hague), The Jazz Café (Camden) and Phoenix Festival as M.D. for Warner Bros recording artist Dana Bryant, as well as The Iridium Jazz Club (NYC). Jeremy soulful style both on the piano and vocally together with his quartet is a joy to the ear.

THE FANTASTICS 08 NOV



Rooted in soul-jazz, blues, latin, funk & fusion but with a distinctly progressive edge, Freestyle Records big hitters 'THE FANTASTICS!' have performed live BBC sessions for Mark Lamarr and Craig Charles and performed incendiary live shows around the UK and across Europe.

The 2009 debut album 'Mighty Righteous' ripped up the rigidly defined genres of 'deep funk', leaving some purists bemused, but bringing a fresh of breath air into a scene filled with samey sounds and live bands. Now featuring the stunning vocal talents of Sulene Fleming, this band are comfortable blending soul, blues, funk rock, afrobeat, latin jazz, fusion, a whiff of ska and whatever takes their fancy.

THE SOUL IMMIGRANTS 15 NOV



Formed in 1992 by Emrys Baird and Nitin Sawhney, The Soul Immigrants continue to make 'original, but intelligent jazzy, deep funk grooves.' This six piece, are real funk masters for sure with the grittiest of horn sections and vocals to die for! This is retro, feel good music - unashamedly yesterday's sounds for today!

SARAVAH SOUL 15 NOV



Exploding out of the cross-cultural melting-pot of London's underground music scene comes the half-Brazilian, half-British SARAVAH SOUL with their own special blend of Afro-Brazilian rhythms, 60's soul and Afrobeat.

Their first album was an internationally acclaimed sensation that took them touring all over Europe and Brazil with an intense, tightly honed live show, led by frenetic dancer and front-man Otto Nascarella and complete with carnival percussion parades, a festival favourite.

FUNKY MUCHACHOS 17 NOV



A sweet set of funky instrumentals from the Funky Muchachos – a combo who usually record under the guise of Tito Lopez, and who have a classic soul jazz approach to their groove! The core trio features drums, bass, and either organ or electric piano, depending on the track – and some cuts add in a bit of guest instrumentation on flute or guitar to round out the sound slightly. The keyboards are

great – often quite stark and spare, with as much rhythmic focus as the other players in the group – and the electric piano tracks are especially nice, with a groove that's warm, but never too smooth or slick.

SNOWBOY & THE LATIN SECTION 17 NOV



SNOWBOY (real name Mark Cotgrove) is a Latin Percussionist and DJ. He has played professionally for Aírto Moreira, Imelda May, Mark Ronson, Flaco Jimenez, Basia, Lisa Stansfield, Mick Hucknall, James Taylor Quartet, Incognito, Jon Lucien and, of course, is a recording artist and band leader performing with his own Afro-Cuban Jazz group - Snowboy and The Latin Section.

He is without doubt, the country's best known Latin percussionist and his band is probably Europe's most travelled Latin Jazz act. He sees himself in the future as recording as many albums and playing live as much as he can to continue to spread his brand of furious, hardcore Afro Cuban Jazz around the furthest reaches of the planet, and as the unofficial ambassador for the U.K's Jazz Dance scene!!

AYDENNE SIMONE & JAZZ CULTURE 22 NOV



Aydenne Simone has performed with her band, Jazz Culture, in some of London's top venues over many years, including: The Jazz Café and Jazz on The Park; You'll hear songs from the greats, including Duke Ellington, Sarah Vaughan, Ella Fitzgerald and many more. You can have a bit of funk, soul and rhythm 'n' blues thrown in too for good measure too, if you'd like!

In 16 years Aydenne has not ended a performance yet without the audience calling for an encore!

ATILA 22 NOV



Singer Atila and his band bring the music of such greats like Frank Sinatra and Dean Martin back into life with fresh, yet dignified, versions of classic tunes. These young musicians, educated at the UK's most prestigious conservatories, enchant their audience every time, no matter whether they are performing at their own concerts or acting as support acts for musicians such as Buddy Greco. Digby

Fairweather describes Atila as "the best I've heard from a British singer and orchestra since Dame Cleo and Sir John Dankworth's Shakespeare and All That Jazz."

JOANNA EDEN 24 NOV



Singer pianist Joanna Eden plays a mixture of originals and standards. Joanna's reputation continues to build after Michael Parkinson recently enthused about her live performances and CDs. Joanna and her band perform a blend of jazz with a latin twist.

FUNKADELIC FUNSHONE 24 NOV



Funkshone are an original funk act from the UK created by musician, DJ and producer Mike Bandoni, Producer Nino Auricchio plus special guests.

This 9-piece band offers a storming live show comprising of original deep funk gems alongside better-known and some not so well known obscure funk covers. Expect wild funk drum breaks and a razor sharp rhythm section, driven bass lines, killer horn lines and a whole lot of soul from the soul funk powerhouse that is Miss Jaelee Small!

ROBIN JONES & KING SALSA 29 NOV



King Salsa was founded by master percussionist and drummer Robin Jones in England in 1986. In its 25 years the band has had a colourful and varied career and has become something of an international institution in Latin (mainly Cuban) music, dance and folklore.

King Salsa has been featured at most of the world's best jazz and Latin venues and festivals. Robin Jones and his thirteen piece orchestra playing Salsa as it would be played in Havana combining jazz and folk influences from Cuba, Puerto Rico, New York and the Dominican Republic.

LINLEY WIER 01 DEC



Linley was born and raised in West London, into a large musical family with strong cultural roots from Tonga and Scotland. With the arrival of a piano into the house when Linley was ten, her love for music really began to blossom.

After graduating with honours from Leeds College of Music, Linley embarked upon a diverse international career - singing, song writing and recording. Following residencies in Tokyo and Dubai, her music has taken her to India, Spain, Ireland, the Maldives and China.

Since returning to the UK, Linley has built a reputation on the London jazz scene, having performed at venues including Pizza on the Park, 606 Club, and the National Theatre, Linley's signature contralto voice is sensitive - authentic - soulful - smoky and original. When Linley performs she is in her element, singing soul-inspired, modern jazz, that is not constrained by traditional genre boundaries.

Linley's performance has a mobility and fluidity, moving seamlessly between the intimate, the energetic and the unexpected, handling an eclectic repertoire with intuitive interplay and a spirited sense of adventure.

OMAR 01 DEC



Omar, is an internationally acclaimed British soul singer, songwriter and musician. Omar grew up in Canterbury, Kent. He learned his craft classically, playing the trumpet, piano and percussion. Omar also spent two years at Chetham's School of Music in Manchester, and the Guildhall School of Music in London. His most well-known song was his debut single "There's Nothing Like This". It reached #14 in the UK

Singles Chart on re-release in 1991. All Music noted that he is described by some as the father of British neo soul.

Omar has appeared with a wealth of top soul talent including Stevie Wonder, Carleen Anderson, Caron Wheeler, Angie Stone and Galliano. Omar was awarded the Best Soul Act at the Urban Music Awards in 2006 and has been nominated for Best UK R&B/Soul Act in this years 2011 MOBO Awards.

NATHAN WATSON 10 DEC
